

**WAYNESBURG BEAGLE CLUB
CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS
REVISED JANUARY 13, 2019**

ARTICLE I NAME

Section 1. In accordance with the certification of incorporation, dated January 12, 1948, and signed by the Honorable John Inghram Hook, President Judge of the Court of Greene County, the name of this organization shall be THE WAYNESBURG BEAGLE CLUB.

Section 2. The charter and its endorsements, with the certificate of incorporation, are recorded in Deed Book Number 441, pages 94-99 in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Greene County, Pennsylvania.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

Section 1. Specifications of the charter : The said corporation is formed for the mutual benefit, aid, enlightenment, enjoyment, and entertainment of its members; to promote improvement and better breeding of thoroughbred Beagle hounds; to encourage interest in the community in the raising and training of Beagle hounds and to promote field trials on a non-profit basis; to maintain headquarters for assembling and meeting for the purposed hereinbefore set forth and to hold real and personal property in accordance with the Acts of Assembly in such cases made and provided.

The said corporation does not contemplate gain or profit incidental or otherwise to its members.

The said corporation shall have the right to maintain and defend judicial proceedings in its corporate name; to make and use a common seal and to alter the same at pleasure; to enter into any obligation necessary for the transaction of its ordinary affairs; to make by-laws not inconsistent with law for the management of its property; the regulation of its affairs and the conduct and deportment of its members; to solicit subscriptions of money and to raise funds in furtherance of said association by dues or donations from its members or others or in any other lawful manner.

The said corporation is to be perpetual and shall maintain its perpetuity by the succession of corporate members and the admission or enrollment of new members from time to time. Application for membership shall be presented at any regular meeting and new members may be admitted by a majority vote of the members present at any regular meeting; the time and place of the regular meeting shall be regulated by the by-laws of the said corporation.

That there is no capital stock of said corporation.

Section 2. In accordance with the aforementioned charter, the purpose of the Waynesburg Beagle Club is to attain the following objectives:

(a) To sponsor trials for beagles in accordance with rules of any association to which it belongs.
