

(b) To maintain an area adequate for the needs of its members for the training and conditioning of beagles on a year around basis, subject to any special rules adopted by a majority vote of the membership present and voting specifying restrictions and conditions covering the use of the training area.

(c) To encourage the development and improvement of the beagle as a breed.

(d) To encourage all members to participate as entrants in field trials sponsored by all of the clubs belonging to the associations with which The Waynesburg Beagle Club is affiliated.

(e) To encourage good sportsmanship and good fellowship among its members and to foster a spirit of cooperation that is conducive to the smooth functioning and successful operation of any organization.

Section 3. All activities of The Waynesburg Beagle Club shall be in keeping with the rules and regulations of beagle clubs with which it may be affiliated.

Section 4. Unless otherwise stated in this Constitution and By-Laws, all business will be conducted according to Roberts Rules of Order.

ARTICLE III ORDER OF BUSINESS

Section 1. The order of business shall be:

1. Reading of minutes.
2. Report of Treasurer.
3. Reading of communications.
4. Report of standing committees.
5. Report of special committees.
6. Report of the Directors.
7. Old business.
8. New business.
9. Payment of dues.
10. Proposal and election of officers.
11. Proposal and election of new members.
12. Good of club.
13. Stating date and time of next meeting.
14. Adjournment.

ARTICLE IV OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES

Section 1. The officers of the club shall be President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and up to six Directors.

Section 2. Duties of Officers.

President. It shall be the duty of the President to preside impartially at all meetings, to preserve order, and to enforce the laws and regulations of the club. The President shall have the right to appoint all committees if there is no provision made for their election by the club or other organization of which the club is a member. The President shall have the right to vote only in case of a tie ballot.
