

Vice President. It shall be the duty of the Vice President to perform the duties of the President if the President is absent or unable to perform his duties. The Vice President shall assume the office of the President if the President resigns or leaves the club.

Secretary. The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the club and shall keep accurate records of all meetings and activities, including field trials. It shall be his duty to notify members of special meetings.

Treasurer. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to be responsible for the collection and expenditures of all monies and he shall keep an accurate record of all transactions. He shall deposit all funds of the club in such a bank as the members of the club designate. When possible, all expenditures shall be made by check and the cancelled checks made a part of the official records.

Directors. It shall be the duties of the Directors to supervise the activities of the club in an advisory capacity, to propose and to initiate plans for its upkeep and improvement, to control the running grounds and their upkeep and improvement, and to serve as custodians of the property and equipment belonging to the club.

The President, Vice President, and the Secretary are ex-officio members of the Directors. Neither can serve as chairman.

ARTICLE V RECORDS

The records of the treasurer shall be audited at least quarterly by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI BILLS FOR PAYMENT

Ordinary bills against the club shall be paid by the Treasurer as funds permit and their payment shall be reported to the members at the next regular meeting. Unusual financial obligations may be referred by the Treasurer to the members for discussion and action.

ARTICLE VII MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. The maximum number of members, not including honorary life members, will be forty (40). Any person desiring to be become a member of the club must make written application for membership and must be proposed by a member in good standing. An interval of at least one calender month must elapse between the meeting at which he is proposed for membership and the meeting at which his application is voted upon.

Section 2. The applicant for membership must own a beagle and be present at either the meeting at which he is proposed for membership or at the meeting at which his application is voted upon.
